This new law applies to young people who are not staying with a parent or guardian and who are experiencing homelessness, including couch-surfing.

There are many types of health care that is included under this new law, such as:

Physical exams,

Vision exams and eyeglasses,



Dental exams,

Hearing exams and hearing aids,



Immunizations,

Treatments for illnesses and conditions, and



Routine follow-up care.
